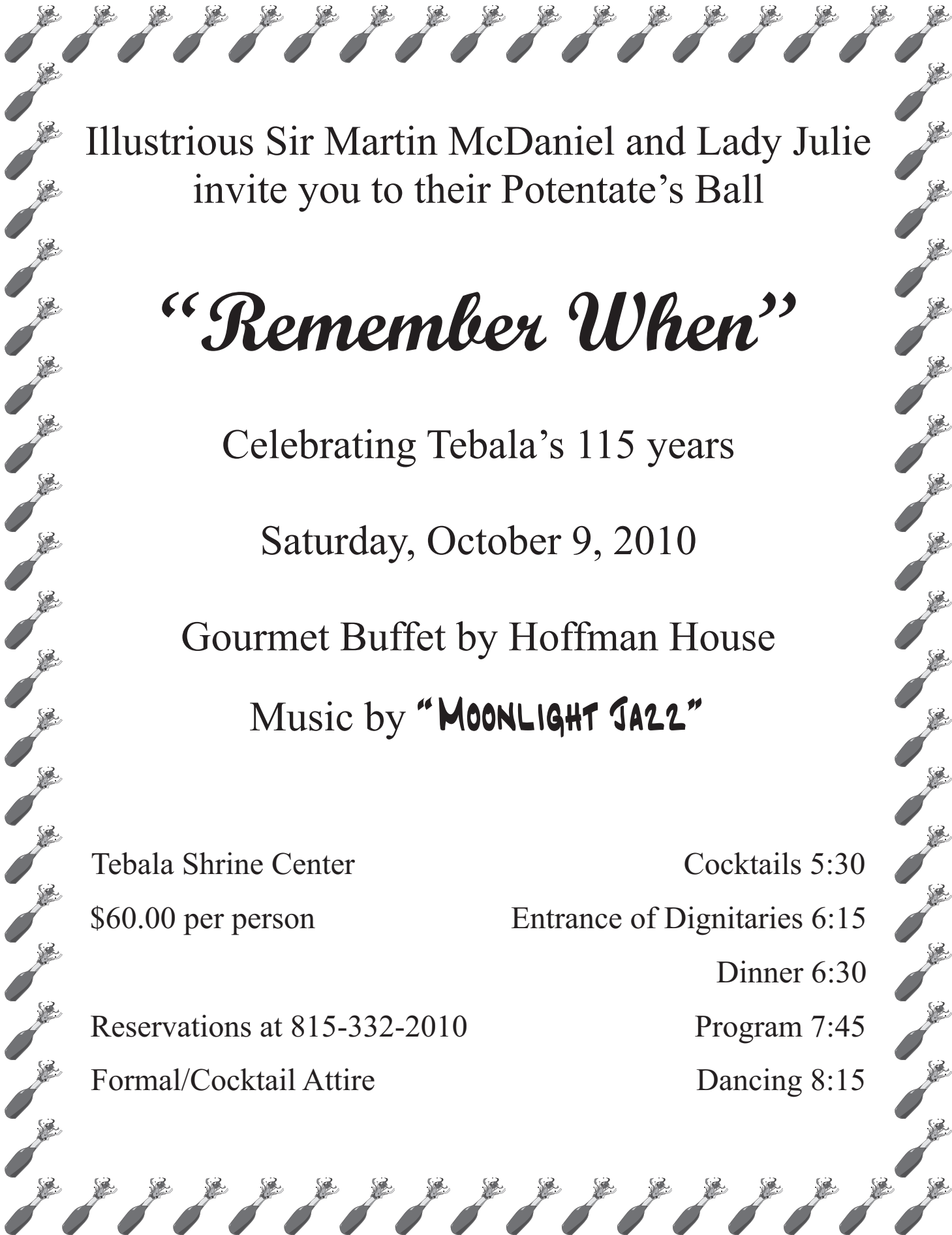

Remember that this fundraiser will help Tebala maintain a 1<sup>st</sup> class rental and meeting facility for years to come.

There will be a permanent commemorative display recognizing those who contribute to this “Project Tebala”.
